Végh, Rebeka: Murderous mothers (4-95)

There are few acts more terrible than the deliberate taking of an innocent child's life, yet it is present everywhere and at all times in human history. What drives a parent to kill her own baby? What kind of problems lie behind this crime? The aim of my thesis is to embrace the complex topic of infanticide and newborn homicide and to offer an explanation for understanding it.

Szekér, Anna: Appearance of generation differences in police communication (96-134)

Generation Z (born between 1995 and 2009) has reached the age when it enters the world of work, so the older generations have to work with colleagues with a very different outlook, qualities and needs. The police are no exception. In my work, I am looking for answers to how the (multi) generational differences are reflected in the internal communication of the police and what difficulties arise in the communication between the younger and the older generation.

Németh, Vivien: Career preferences of young people – The attractiveness of a career in law enforcement (135-178)

As a finance student, I regularly hear and read about the law enforcement field has significant supply problems. During my dissertation, I examined the replenishment of those who served in law enforcement (primarily finance guards). I choose this issue because of in my opinion it's important to identify the causes of the problem related to replenishment, to clarify it and to develop proposals for solutions. However, I am interested in those ideas what young people have about to choose a career in their future job or place of work, and from this point of view, what can be expected regarding the replenishment of law enforcement agencies. Before starting my research, I put forward the hypothesis: The work-related needs of generation Z youth and the demands of a career in law enforcement are not in line

with each other, and this is also an obstacle to orientation to law enforcement agencies and to retention of young people. In the course of my research to establish a theoretical basis, I explored and studied the relevant literature sources about Generation Z, as well as the strategic documents and legislation formulate the expectations of the university and the future employer, and in the case of my thesis, the National Tax and Customs Administration (NTCA). In the framework of secondary research, I also examined the results of major researches and surveys examining workplace preferences published in the National and international literature. I used the aspects revealed by the method of document analysis to compile the questionnaire, which I addressed to students and university students. After processing the resources and the results of the questionnaire, I compared the needs of young people with the expectations of the university and the NTCA. In the end of my dissertation, I formulated my proposals primarily in relation due to recruitment.
